## Cornell Note-taking System cont'd

What are the six steps of the Cornell system?

- \* In class
- \* after class
- \* know/use format
- \* R, R, V
- \* reflect

- Record notes on R of pg
- read over notes to fill in gaps & make more legible
  - w/in 8 hours
- identify main ideas & write Q on L of pg
- Cover R of pg & use recall cues to recite info, & verify
- write summary
- review notes regularly
  - short, fast, frequent reviews = better understanding and recall

- Add info from "Cornell Notes Rubric"
  - notes in pen
  - add/revisions in diff color

Summary: The Cornell Note-taking System is a method which means it is organized and conscious. This system focuses on efficiency a fair amount, but it gives even more credence to reflection & its role in memorization.
